

**Attention Residents and Businesses in the vicinity of:
Moore Street from the Intersection of
US Route 29 to the Intersection of South Railroad Ave.**

On or about 6/1/21 Diamond Construction will be performing work on the above-mentioned street. Work will last between June 1, 2021 to September 24, 2021. Working hours will be between 7 AM – 5 PM (weather permitting) and will consist of installation of granite curbs and concrete curbs, concrete driveway aprons, concrete sidewalks, handicap ramps, crosswalk, and the complete reconstruction of the roadway. During this time, we would appreciate it if you would not leave any vehicles parked on the street between the hours of 7:00 AM and 5 PM. Although there may be times when you may not be able to use your driveway, such as when new curb is being installed across the front of your driveway apron. The street will be passable at all times for residents and emergency and school vehicles. Please follow all signage when operating your vehicle, and please use complete caution when walking/driving through our work area.

Please remove any and all plantings, ornaments and other objects of value within the borough's right-of-way (in most cases this means the area between the sidewalk and the curb) that you don't want to be removed and discarded.

CAUTION: Please have all vehicles moved off the road[s], during the hours of **6am to 6pm**. Any damage to personal property must be documented with a Diamond Construction supervisor the day of the incident. Tack oil will be sprayed on road prior to paving. You are advised not to ride through the tack oil, as it may damage your vehicle.
