Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by the Borough of Stockton, Hunterdon County, State of New Jersey, on **Friday, January 3, 2025 at 11:00 a.m.** local prevailing time at Stockton Borough Hall, 2 South Main Street, Stockton, NJ, 08559, at which time and place proposals will be opened and read in public for the following Contract:

Bidders may submit questions in writing to the Borough no later than **Tuesday, December 3, 2024.**

Bids may be submitted in person or by mail and they will be received at the Municipal Clerk's Office and publicly opened, examined and announced at the above designated date and time. No bids will be received after the above designated date and time. The Borough assumes no responsibility for the loss or the non-delivery of any bid sent to it prior to the bid opening.

Each bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, bank cashier's check or bid bond of an amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the total bid, but not to exceed \$20,000.00, payable to the Borough of Stockton and a Consent of Surety. The Surety shall be bound to furnish bonds as required in the Instructions to Bidders.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27-1.1 et seq. Bidders shall also be required to comply with all other requirements as set forth in the Instructions to Bidders.

The Borough intends to award this project to the lowest responsible bidder whose bid is responsive and complies with its requirements for same, provided that in the judgment of the Borough it is reasonable, and within available funds of the Borough. The Borough reserves the right to consider the bids for sixty (60) days after receipt thereof, and further reserves the right to reject any and all bids, waive informalities, and make such awards or take action in accordance with applicable law.
