June 3, 2025 Meeting Minutes

The Stockton Borough Planning Board Regular Meeting was held via Zoom and called to order on June 3, 2025 at 7:00pm by Chair Bonanni who read the following statement: Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided by a notice mailed to the Hunterdon County Democrat and The Trenton Times posted on the Borough Website, on the window of Borough Hall, and filed with the Borough Clerk as required by law.

Mr. Bonanni read the following: The Board's General Policy is to end the presentation of testimony on applications and Board discussions by 9:00 PM and to conclude all Board business by 9:30 PM. When necessary, the Chair may permit a reasonable extension of those time limits. This meeting is being held via Zoom, a cloud-based web conferencing program. This meeting is being conducted pursuant to guidance from the Division of Local Government Services ("DLGS"). https://www.nLgov/govconnectinews/general/#8. Open to the Public – Agenda Items

Chair Bonanni opened the meeting for Public Comment. Ms. St. Angelo noted that any comments for the Housing Plan Element and Fair Share Plan should be held for the Public Hering portion later in the meeting. Seeing no comments, Chair Bonanni closed this portion of the meeting

Public Hearing - Housing Plan Element and Fair Share Plan

Ms. Slagle stated that Stockton Borough participated in the second round of affordable housing and also started the third round but dropped out along with other municipalities due to the litigation costs. The Borough is now participating in the 4th round of Affordable Housing.



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Ms. Slagle reviewed the Housing Plan Element and Fair Share Plan Draft memo and what the Borough responsibilities are: updated development fee ordinance for affordable housing, updating affordable housing ordinance for administration and regulation for the immediate future, but other responsibilities can wait until there are affordable housing units actually being built in the Borough. Vacant lot adjustment is for municipalities like Stockton Borough, who do not have land base large enough for affordable housing zoning, which means if and when vacant land becomes available it will be utilized for affordable housing. This was granted to Stockton in the second and third rounds of affordable housing, and she anticipates it will be granted to the Borough again in the fourth round of affordable housing. Stockton can also implement a mandatory set aside ordinance — which means if anyone comes in with residential development of 5 units or more it will be required that 1 unit will be designated affordable housing. The Borough does have a development fee ordinance that collects money that can be put towards creation of affordable housing, but nothing that has been done in the Borough meets this and the trust has a zero balance. Ms. Slagle also asked for a waiver of administrative items in the program until we need them, since there are no units and no trust fund. This includes hiring requirements for affordable housing and would be a financial burden on the Borough for something they can not implement at this time.

7:12pm – Mr. Miller entered the meeting.

Mr. Gallagher asked about the map on the last page that is color coded. The Anderson tract is marked as open space and he asked if it should be indicated preserved space. Ms. Slagle indicated that open space includes preserved space/Green Acres.

Mr. Bonnani – Asked if page 27 said that this is that all available land was assessed and is not considered developable for this process, and Ms. Slagle affirmed this. She further clarified that it is for affordable inclusionary, a minimum of 6 units per acre.

Mr. Bonanni thanked Ms. Slagle for her work on this and opened the floor to Board Members. Ms. Slagle quickly reviewed the process for adopting this plan. Ms. St. Angelo further clarified the requirements for an objection to the plan.

Seeing no further Board questions or comments, Chair Bonanni open this portion of the meeting for comments from the Public.

Seeing no comments from the Public, Chair Bonanni closed this portion of the meeting.

Motion by Ms. Bassett to Adopt the Housing Plan Element and Fair Share Plan. Second by Ms. Brown.
